- a. Capacity Building Update:** The Capacity Building Workshop was held on December 12, 2017 with approximately 62 attendees and hosted by Rebecca Janowitz (Special Assistant for Legal Affairs), Patrick McPhilimy (Grants Coordinator) and LaToscha Hoover (Grants Monitor).
 - b. Grants Awarded 2018/19:** The Justice Advisory Council awarded 48 traditional grants, in the areas of Violence Prevention, Recidivism Reduction and Restorative Justice which includes 1 and 2 year grants with a total of \$5.6 million in awards.
 - c. MacArthur Safety & Justice Challenge Update:** Cook County received the \$1.8 million to reduce jail population. The court reminder telephone calls will be in 5 languages and text messages are forth coming. The JAC contributed bus passes for medical appointments.
 - d. 2018 Plans:** The Justice Advisory Council is developing legislative goals.
