- I. Call to Order:** JAC Chair Burke called the meeting to order at 8:30am.
- II. Remarks:** Chair Burke welcomed everyone.
- III. Review of Minutes:** Chair Burke asked Council Members to review the minutes from January 19, 2017 and a motion for approval was moved, seconded and approved.
- IV. Council Discussion:**
- a. Request for Proposals Update:** The Justice Advisory Council has three programs, Violence Prevention (\$300K 2-year), Restorative Justice (\$80K 2-year) and Recidivism Reduction (\$200k 2 year). The total amount of awardee granted was 20 two year grants; the proposals are due March 14th.
 - b. MacArthur Safety and Justice Challenge Update:** Is an award to Jurisdictions to look at ways to reduce jail population. The grant is shared within County partners, state attorney office, office of chief judge, circuit court, sheriff office; police, etc....The Justice Advisory Council hired a Community Engagement Coordinator under the grant.
 - c. Career Launch Update:** The Justice Advisory Council has three providers, Brighton Park Neighborhood Council, Vision of Restoration and Westside Health Authority. We currently have 44 applicants and 26 qualified.
 - d. 2018 Plans:** The Justice Advisory Council is developing legislative goals.
