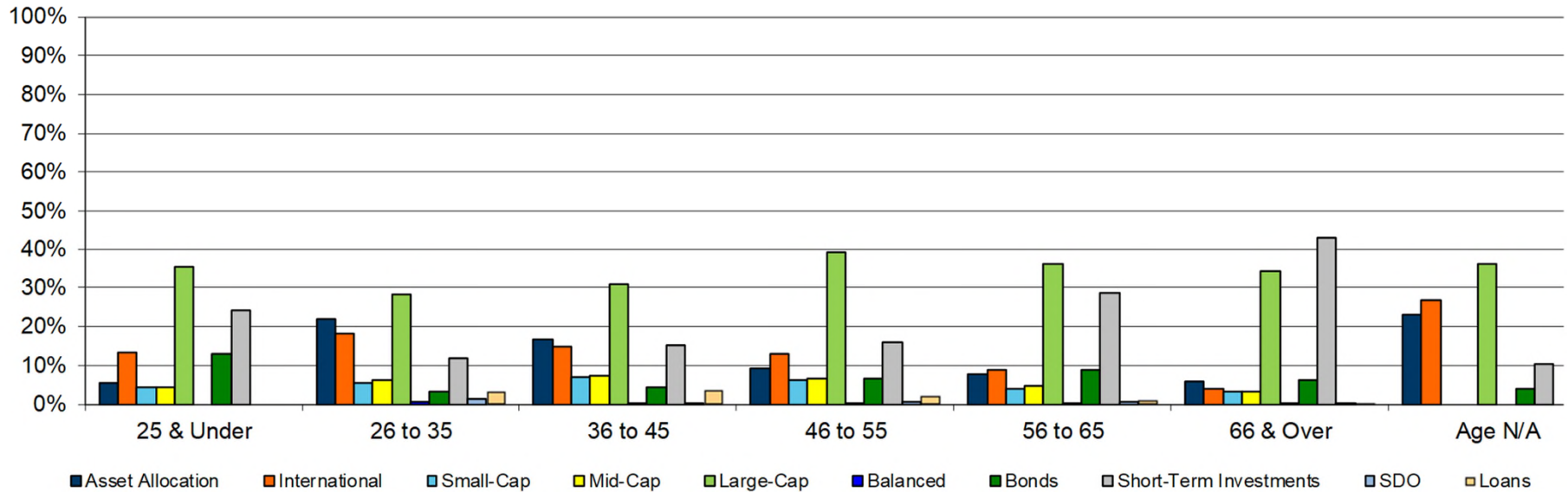

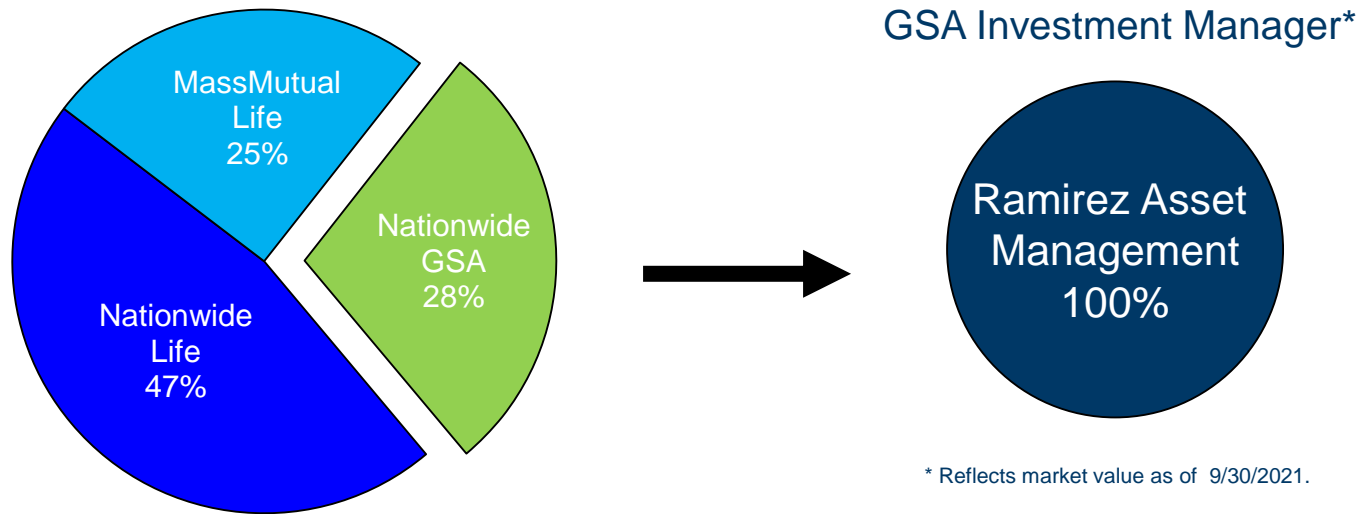

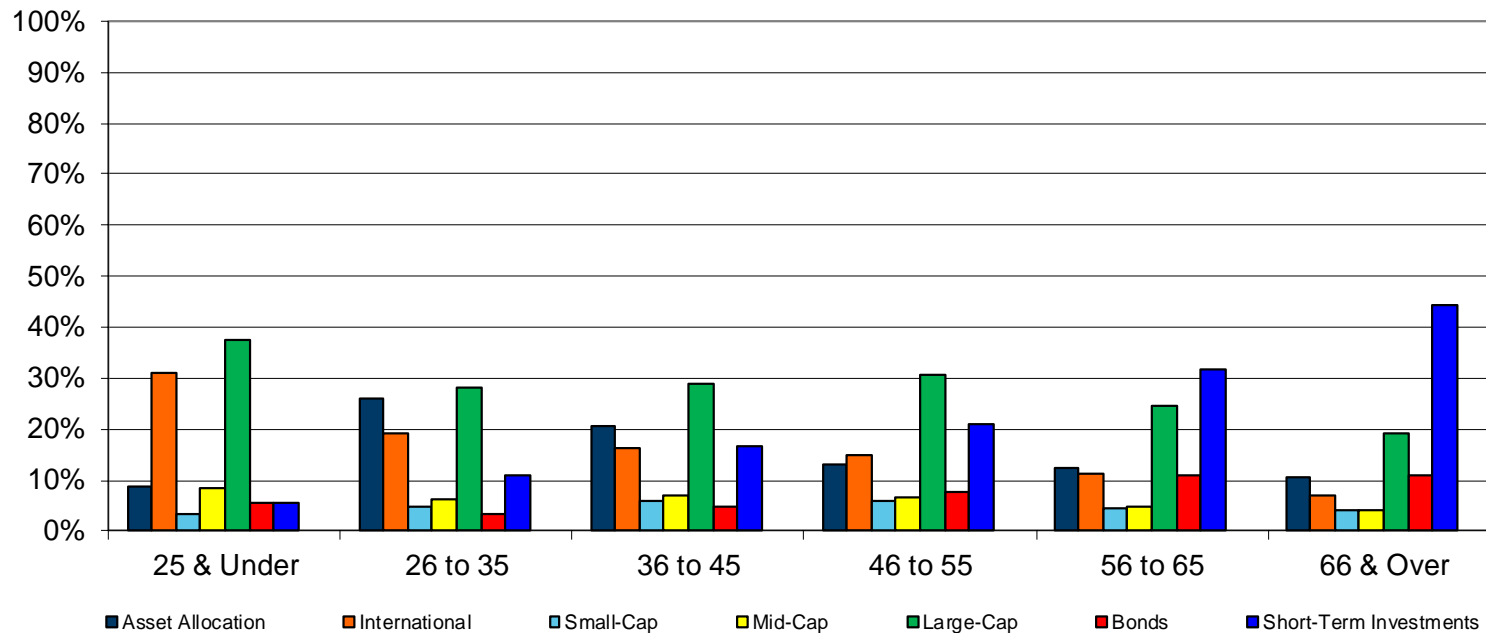

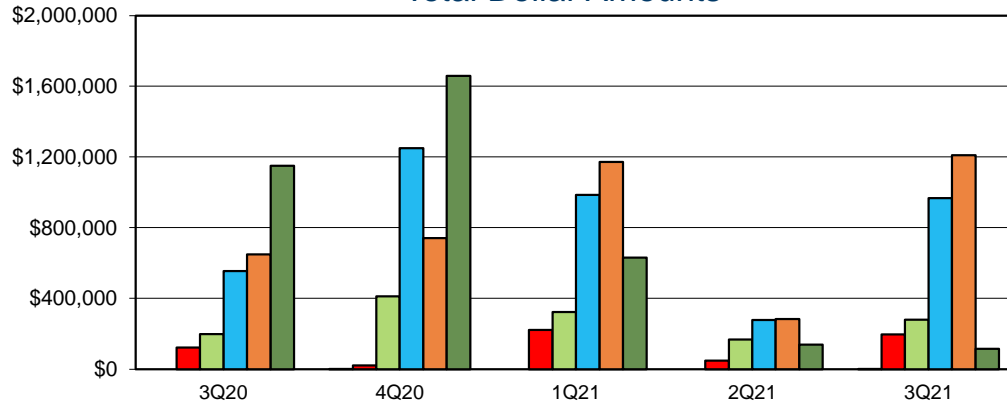

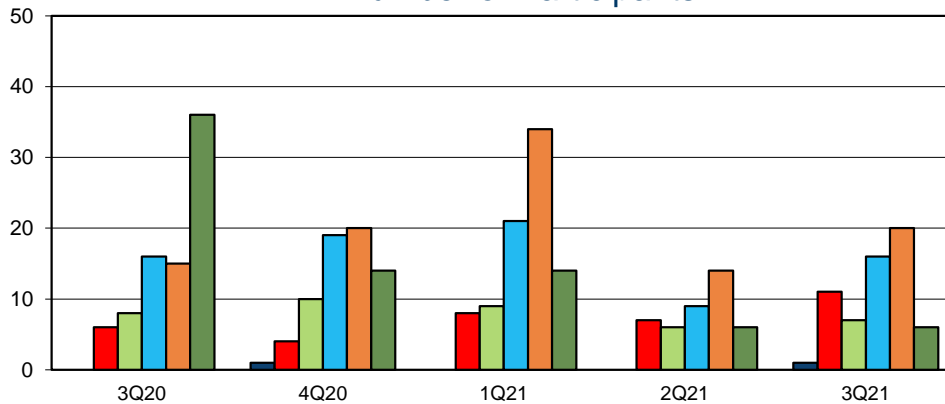

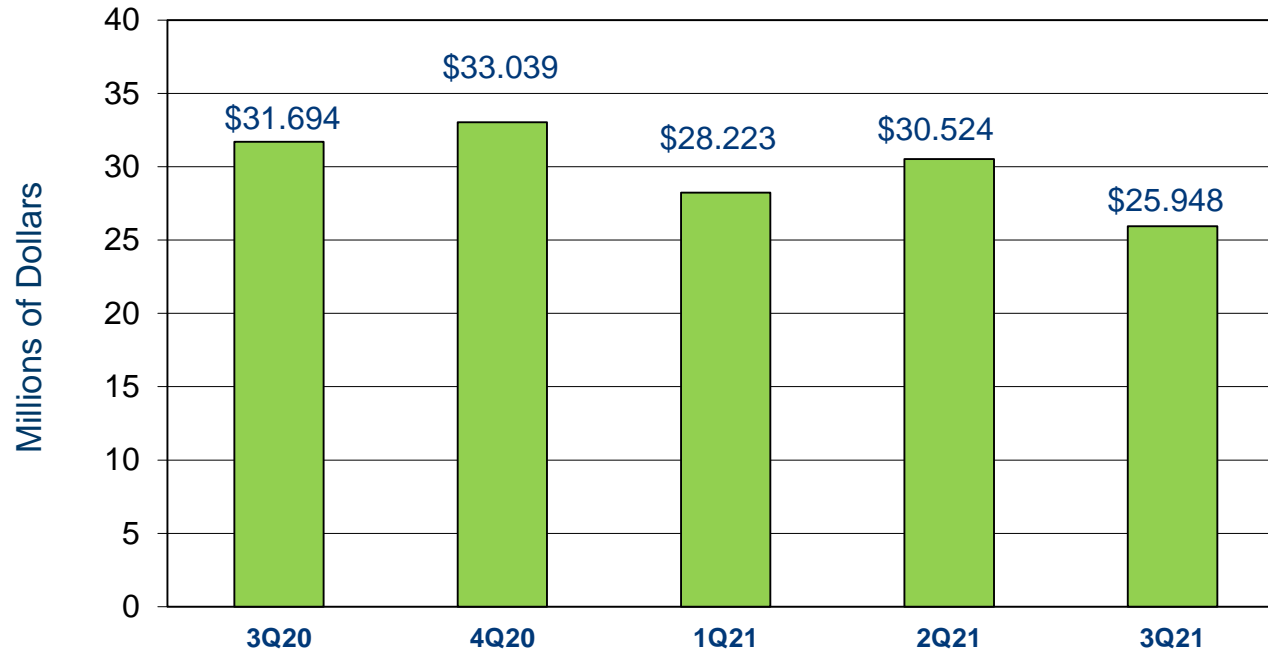

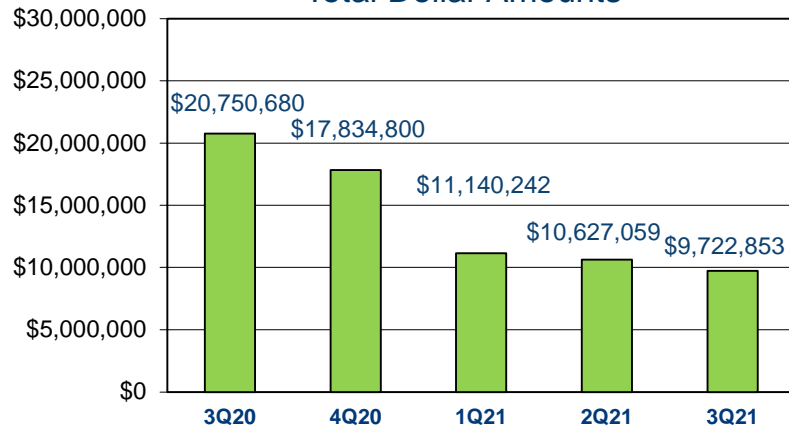

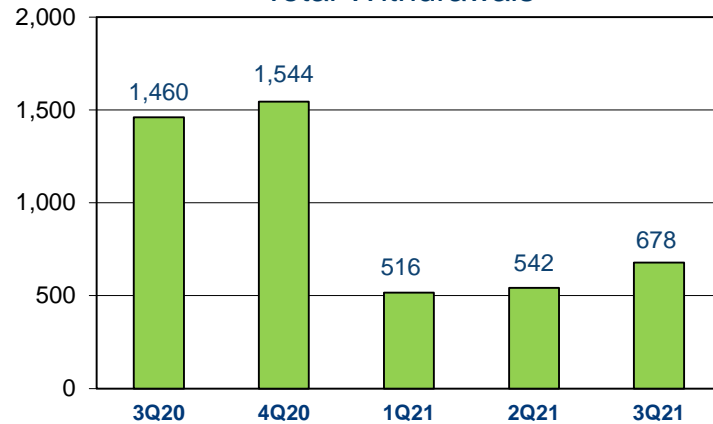

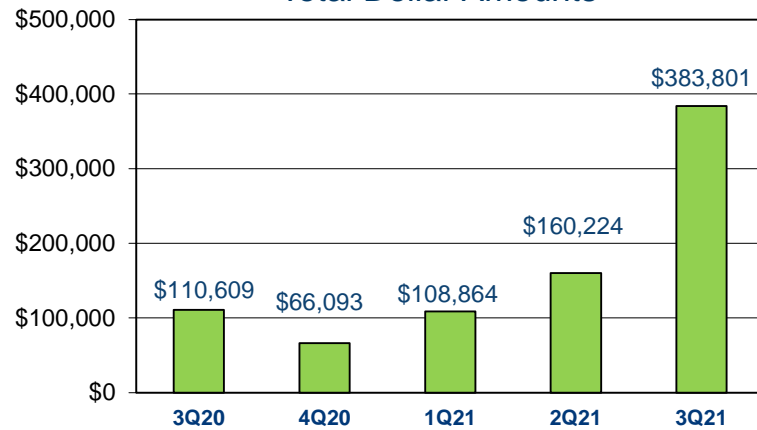

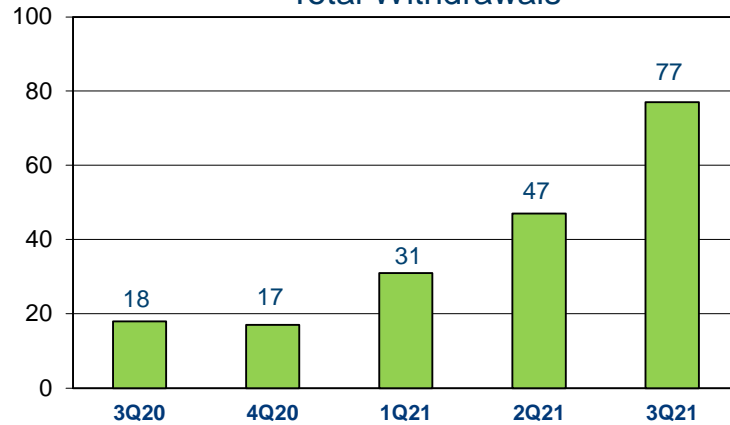
Unforeseeable Emergency Distribution Activity*

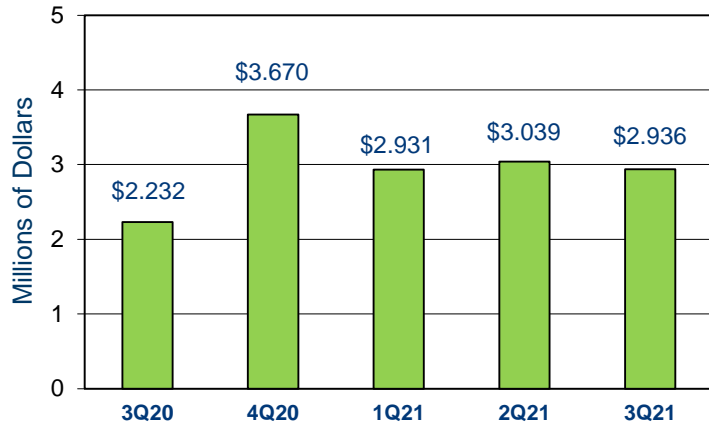

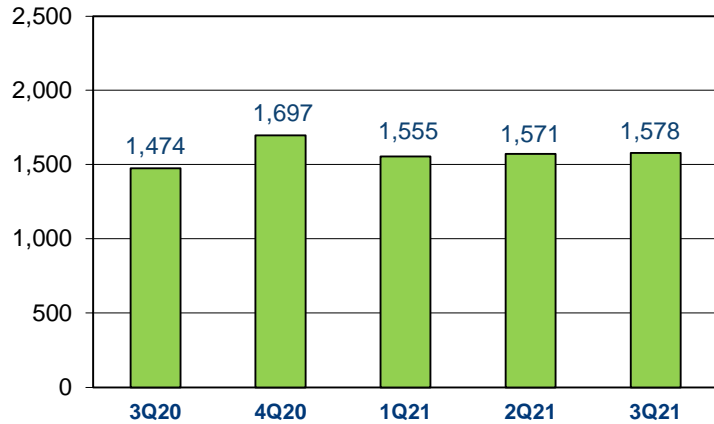
Systematic Withdrawal Activity*

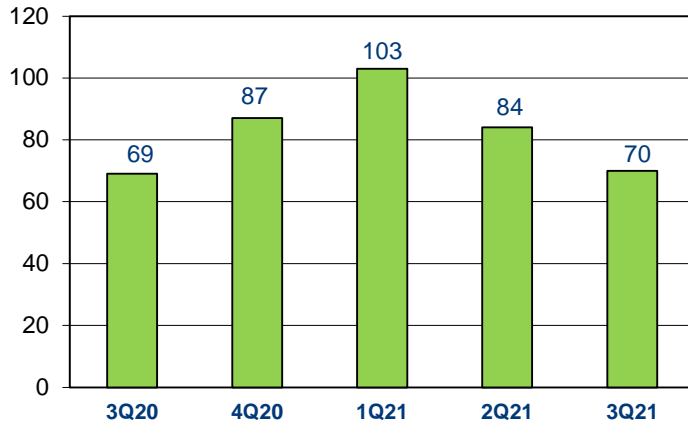

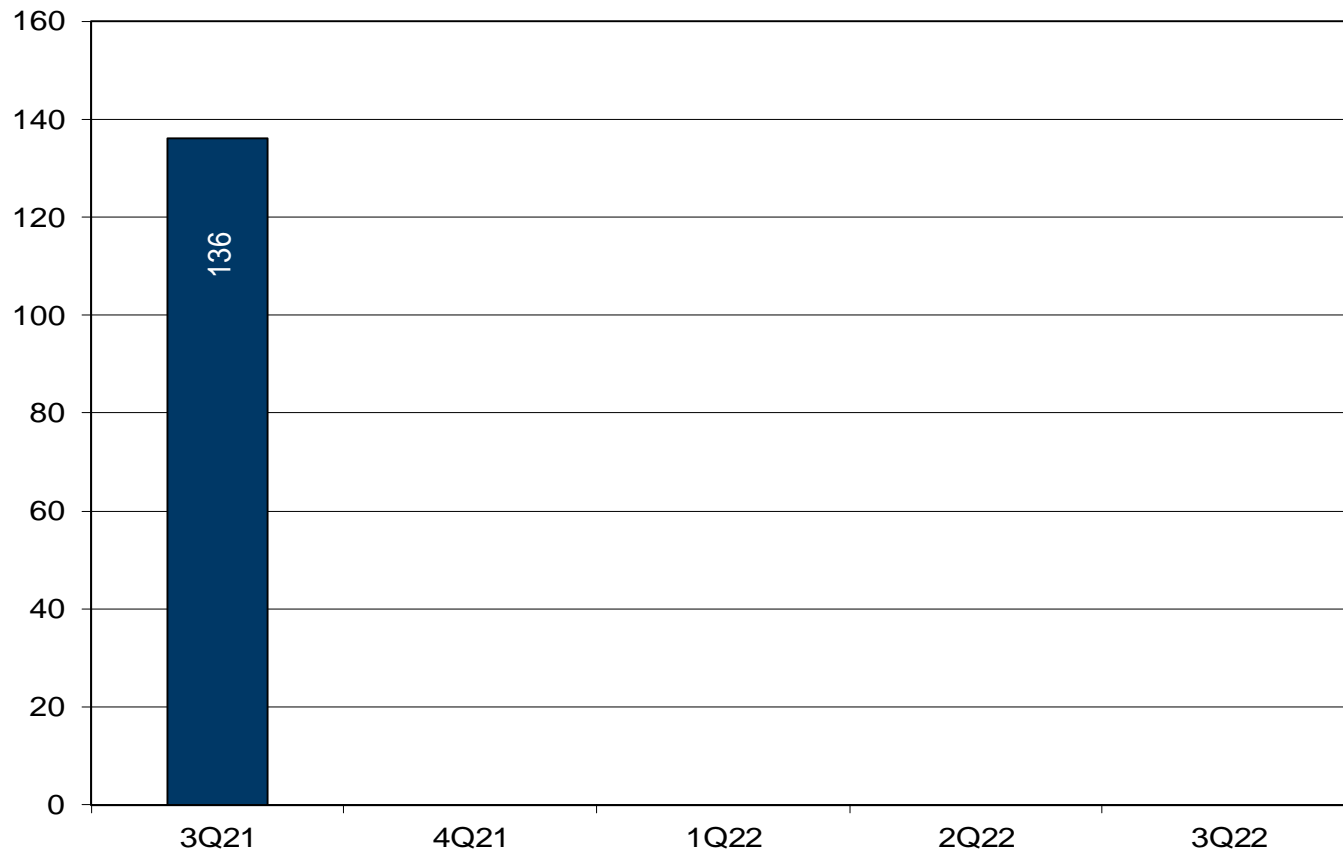

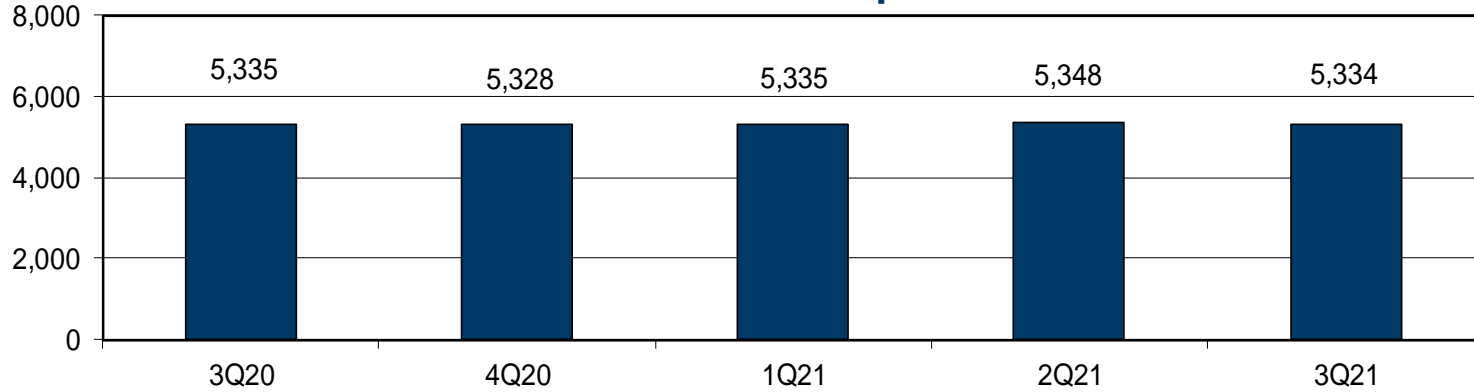
Assets Under Management



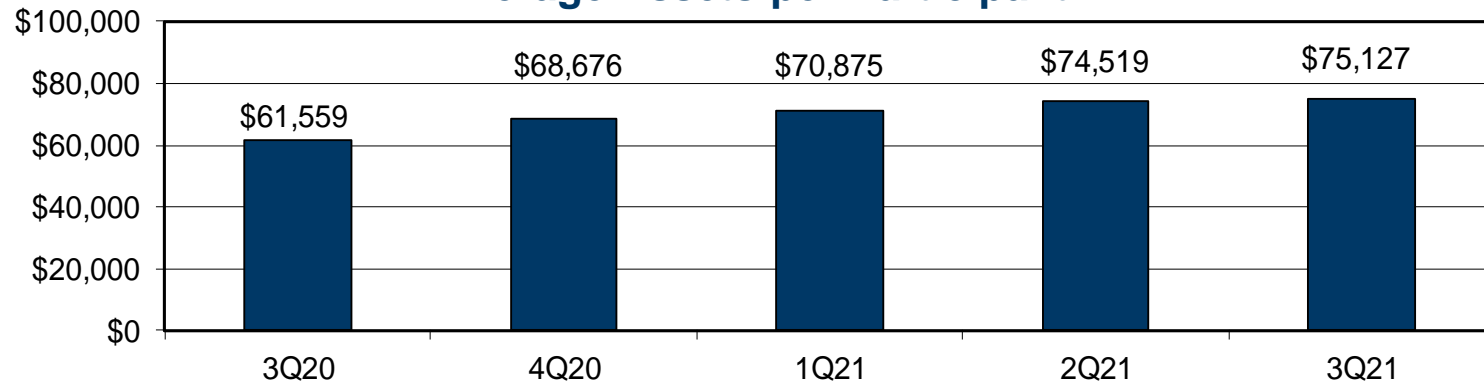
