

COOK COUNTY SUN AND SAVE

The Program

Cook County Sun and Save will install solar photovoltaic systems at no cost for income-qualified residences and homeowners in Cook County for a limited time. This program makes solar installations more accessible for eligible Cook County residents.







- Homeowners of single-family and small multi-family residences of four units or less located within Cook County.
- The property must be owner occupied. The primary program applicant must reside at the property and have the legal authority to allow contractors to complete solar installation and related work on the property.
- The household income must be between 80% - 120% of Area Median Income (AMI). AMI is adjusted for the number of people living in the home. Check out the website for more details.
- Homeowners must complete an application to participate in the program and work with a Cook County Sun and Save qualified installer. The application and program details are available on the Cook County Sun and Save website.
