Background

In 2022 **The Cook County Equity Task Force** recommended that Cook County establish a grant program to support cannabis related businesses that hold Social Equity Licenses, as defined under the Illinois Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act, to recognize the record of incarceration and exclusion communities of color have faced due to the War on Drugs.

Subsequently, the County committed to utilizing funds from **Cook County's Fund for Equity and Inclusion** (Equity Fund) to support the establishment of the Cannabis Development Grant program. Funds are included in the 2024 County budget.

Program Overview

The **Cook County Cannabis Development Grant** offers **up to \$3.6 million** in grants to social equity-licensed cannabis businesses to support startup and operational business costs in Cook County.

To be eligible, businesses must have been awarded **licenses under the State of Illinois Adult-Use Cannabis Social Equity Program** and be committed to locate their cannabis-based business in Cook County.

Four (4) types of grants, based on license type:

1. **Craft grower** licensees are eligible to receive **\$150,000** grants.
2. **Dispensary** licensees are eligible to receive **\$75,000** grants.
3. **Infuser** licensees are eligible to receive **\$100,000** grants.
4. **Transporter** licensees are eligible to receive **\$75,000** grants.

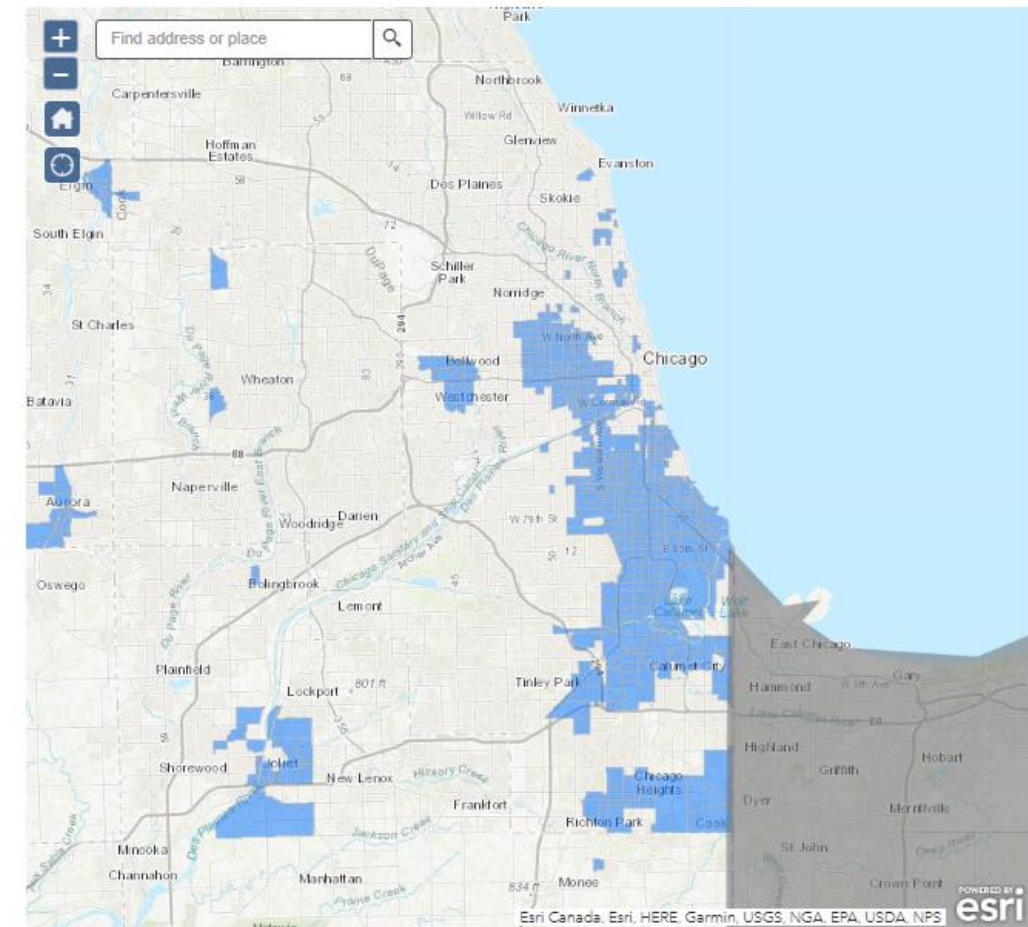
Program Priorities

If the Program receives more eligible applications than it can fund, priority consideration will be given to:

- Businesses issued cannabis licenses in **2021** or **2022**
- Businesses that currently **operate in a Disproportionately Impacted Area (DIA)** or have committed to do so
- Businesses that are **majority-owned (51%+) by individuals who currently reside in DIAs**

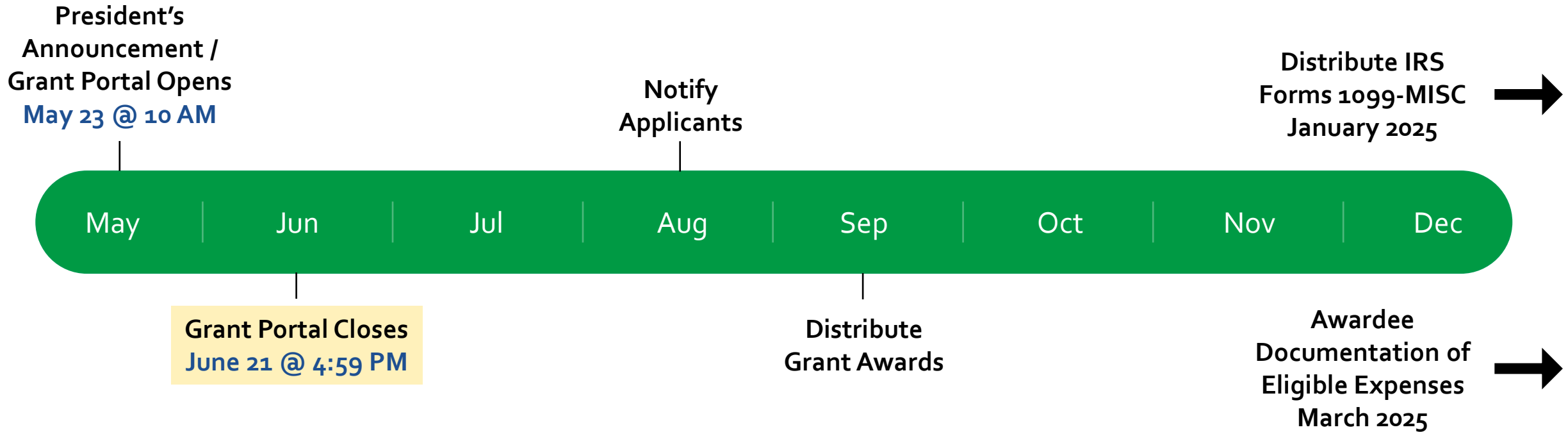
Disproportionate Impacted Area Map

Program Timeline

Grant portal opens **May 23** and will remain open for **4 weeks**.
Distribution of grant awards is targeted for **September**.

Terms & Conditions

1. **I am an owner of the business** referenced in this application.
2. **I am not an employee of Cook County, Illinois, nor is any member of my immediate family or household an employee of Cook County, Illinois.** I acknowledge that Cook County, Illinois government employees and members of their immediate family or household are not eligible for the CCC Development Grant. "Immediate family or household member" means the spouse, child, parent, brother, sister, grandparent, or grandchild, whether of whole blood or half blood or by adoption, or a person who shares a common dwelling.
3. **I am licensed under the State of Illinois Adult-Use Cannabis Social Equity Program to own and operate a cannabis-based business.** If I am applying for a grant for my dispensary business, my dispensary license is valid for operating a facility in **BLS Region 5: Chicago-Naperville-Elgin.**
4. For businesses that are open and operating: my business is located in and operates in Cook County, Illinois. For businesses that are not yet open and operating: my business will be located in and operate in Cook County, Illinois. **If my business locates outside of Cook County, I acknowledge that I must return the entire amount of the grant award to Cook County.**
5. **My business does not have an IRS tax lien or other liens or judgment(s) against it, and the business owners or partners are not currently undergoing bankruptcy proceedings.**

Terms & Conditions (cont'd.)

6. I will use this grant, if selected, to cover only eligible business-related expenses for the business referenced in this application, and **within six (6) months after the grant award date, will provide BED with acceptable documentation**, to be determined by BED, that confirms the date, amount and nature of the eligible expenses. **If I cannot verify that grant funds were used for eligible business expenses, I acknowledge that I must return the entire amount of the grant award to Cook County.**
7. I acknowledge that the CCC Development Grant is governed under Illinois law and that **if I am awarded a grant, I will comply with all applicable state and local orders, laws, regulations, rules, policies and certifications governing any activities undertaken using grant funds** received through a CCC Development Grant, including but not limited to any compliance with prevailing wage laws.
8. **I will respond fully and accurately to the post-award impact survey administered by BED** within 12 months of the grant award date.
9. **All information contained in this application is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate**, and I understand that a materially false statement willfully or fraudulently made in connection with this application may result in rendering the business that holds the cannabis license ineligible with respect to a CCC Development Grant, and, in addition, may subject the person making the false statement to criminal charges.
