## Open Enrollment 2025

Time to mark your calendars for Open Enrollment. Starting October 14 and for two weeks only, you can modify your enrollment status and provisions.

During Open Enrollment you can:

- Update your health benefit plan enrollments.
- Add or remove dependents.
- Enroll/re-enroll in a health and/or dependent day care Flexible Spending Account (FSA).
- Enroll in a voluntary benefit plan.

If you do not have any changes to make to your benefits, you do not have to do anything unless you want to re-enroll in the FSA, which requires annual enrollment.

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## 2025 OPEN ENROLLMENT RUNS FROM OCTOBER 14 – 31.

You may make changes to benefit elections for you and your dependents through the Employee Self Service during this window.

## Open Enrollment | Voluntary Benefits Enhancements

Several enhancements have been made to the 2025 Cook County Voluntary Benefits plan. In addition to the changes detailed below, the FSA contribution amount has been increased to \$3,200. The FSA Dependent Care contribution amount remains at \$5,000.

## Flexible Spending Account (FSA)

An Optum Financial FSA provides a great opportunity to save and pay for eligible health care expenses. Here's how it works:



**Save up to 30%\* on health care.** When you contribute to an FSA, you're setting aside money before it's taxed. This means that you can save up to 30% by using pre-tax funds to pay for your health care needs.

## Flexible Spending Account (FSA)



"Use it or lose it" rule: Cook County allows you to incur eligible expenses through March 15 of the following year.



Paying for expenses is easy. The FSA card can be used to cover copayments, prescription refills, and other health care related expenses. Save time by not having to submit receipts or paper claims forms. Not all purchases are automatically verified, though, so we do recommend that you keep all of your receipts — just in case you're asked for them later.



What can I buy? From bandages and braces to chiropractic care and contacts, FSAs cover many everyday health care items and services. For a complete list of eligible items and services visit https://store.optum.com/expense-eligibility/.
