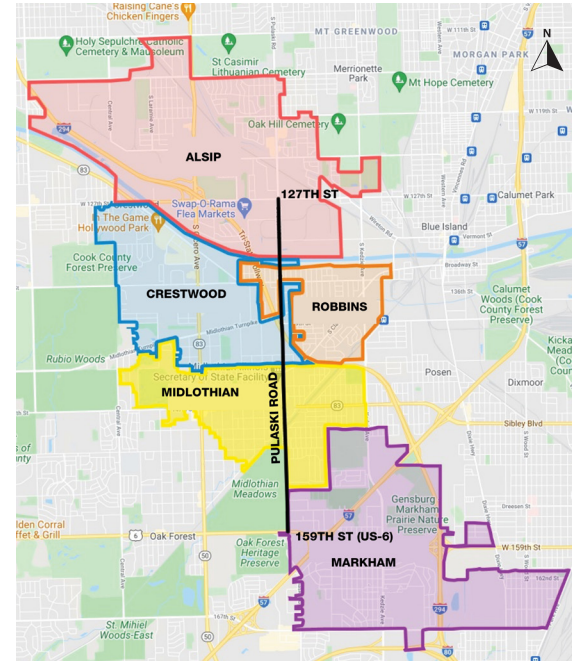


PULASKI ROAD CORRIDOR STUDY

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways (DoTH) is proposing improvements to **Pulaski Road between 159th Street and 127th Street**. The purpose of this project is to improve safety, operational efficiency, mobility and facility conditions within this corridor.



PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- **Corridor-wide roadway modernization** which includes narrowing lanes and changing the median to a flush painted style, supporting left turn movements
- **New sidewalks and a shared-use path** to enhance pedestrian and bicycle access throughout the corridor
- **New turning lanes** at four intersections along the corridor to improve traffic flow
- At 155th Street, **a new path connection** to the Tinley Creek Trail in Midlothian Meadows
- **Safety improvements** at railroad-roadway at-grade crossings
- **Add pedestrian crosswalks** and ADA ramps at intersections
- **Modernize traffic signals** throughout the corridor
- **Rehabilitation of** existing structures (bridges and culverts)
- **Planned improvements** to roadway drainage

PROJECT BENEFITS

- **Improved roadway** conditions
- **Increased safety** for vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists
- **Drainage improvements** to reduce roadway flooding
- **Intersection improvements** to enhance safety and traffic operations
- **Increased connectivity** for bicycles and pedestrians and improved sidewalk connections

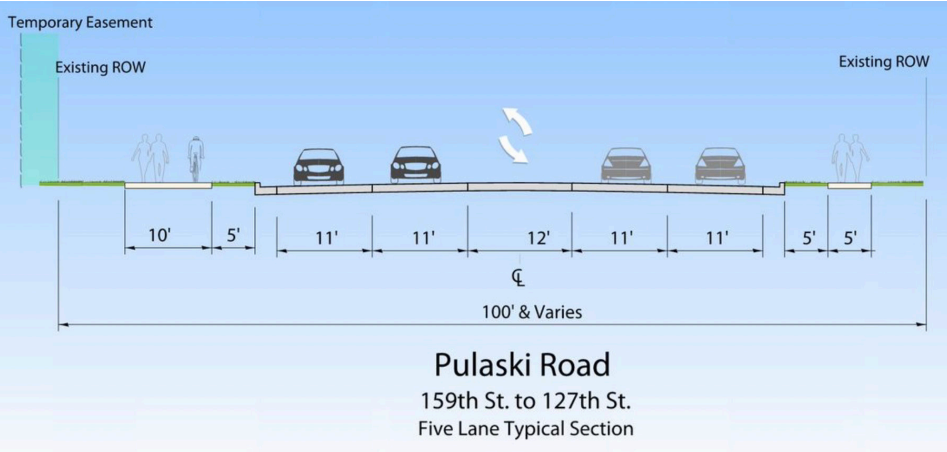

- Modernize the roadway
 - Four 11-foot travel lanes
 - 12-foot flush center median/left turn lanes to support left turn movements
- New turn lanes at four intersections along the corridor to improve traffic flow
- New sidewalks and shared-use path
- Minimize impacts to adjacent properties

CONSTRUCTION STAGING

Proposed improvements to be broken into multiple phased contracts:

- 159th Street to Metra Crossing
- Metra Crossing to Tri-State Tollway
- Tri-State Tollway to Cal-Sag Channel
- Cal-Sag Channel to 127th Street
- Improvements to be performed over multiple years pending funding availability
- Work will be staged to maintain at least one lane of traffic open in each direction on Pulaski Road throughout the project
- Access to all properties to be maintained during construction
- Design anticipated to begin in 2026, and earliest construction will commence is 2028
